




Pitch

Before sacrificing herself to end the destruction, Adara shared a final prophecy: This will happen again, and it will be much worse. But the land and sea will join to create a powerful bloodline, guided by two paladins, and they will bring forth the end to the reign of evil.

The series begins with an unfortunate individual named Ravan, who seeks power to bring back his murdered family. Along the way, he learns of the Holy Wars, the various World Wonders created by the Fairy Circle, and the seductive powers of the forbidden Southern Arts. He's lured by one of the "saints" who was long rumored to have died by the power Adara wielded in her sacrifice, and he learns of the power the prophesied bloodline and their paladins will





possess when they reach their full potential. Their blood will guarantee the resurrection of his family, and the signs that these individuals will be born soon are undeniable.

One patriarch of this bloodline becomes king on land, and the other becomes emperor beneath the ocean in a world where land and sea do not get along. Then, due to the selfishness and jealousy of an empress, the ocean's descendent is sent to land, where she's prophesied to marry the descendant of that patriarch. Soon, Ravan is not the only force the bloodline and its paladins need to fear. The salt blood of the daughter of the ocean becomes known, and the people of the land are not too pleased when she marries their prince. But the land and sea have joined in marriage, and soon they join in blood with their own children, who must deal with the subsequent civil war.

More forces continue to fight this union while the prophesied evil grows, and Ravan continues his hunt. Throughout the series, the audience will enjoy a complex storyline with diverse and complicated characters. There will be war for the viewers who like action, politics for the viewers who enjoy tense plots, love triangles and forbidden love for those who enjoy romance, magic for those who enjoy risky spells, journeys for those who enjoy adventures through thoroughly-built lands, and magical creatures for those who enjoy mythology. The storyline will be easy to follow for viewers who like surface-level entertainment, but there will be thick, underlying details for those who like complex lore.
